- Two Circles meet the first Wednesday of the month, Ruth at 9:30 AM, Martha at 1:30 PM and Rachel at 7:15 PM the first Tuesday of the month.

- Throughout the year we have many great speakers from our community telling of their services and needs. We support many local organizations such as Caritas and Hands of Faith.
- We support the Milwaukee Christian Center through our White Cross collections of many needed items to help them operate efficiently and meet the needs of others.
- Our World Mission offering provides much needed assistance to the Guave Ebenezer Clinic in Haiti.
- March 16 at 9:30 a.m. we will be hosting our 22nd annual "Sharing of the Bread". This is an ecumenical outreach to our community. Our speaker this year will be Rev. Melva Bishop, a pastor from Madison. All in the area are welcome.
